Business Arising from Minutes:

- Hurstville Council has completed most of the work, front area carpeted, new fire door still needs finishing off and rubbish removed.
- Kids on Canvas will be having 4 workshops during school holiday, on the basis of renting premises from us. Karina will be in Centre during these workshops.
